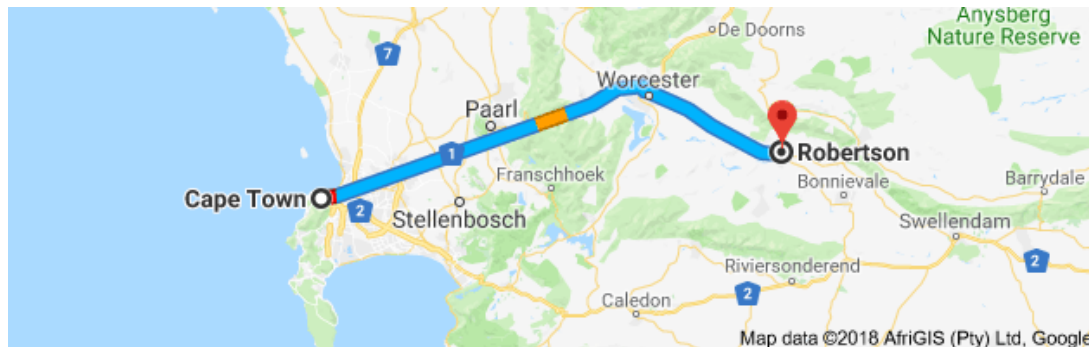


Map and Directions from Cape Town to Good Hope Farm



DIRECTIONS:

Please take the N1 from Cape Town to Worcester.

From Worcester, you need to take the R60 to Robertson.

Please keep your eyes open for speed traps between Worcester and Robertson. You will often find a camera as you come in to Robertson just after the Four Cousins Tasting Room and Restaurant where the speed drops rapidly over a short distance!

Upon entering Robertson, you will pass the SHELL petrol station on your left, followed by Spur, KFC and Bourbon Street, also on your left.

You will then come to a 4-way stop where you will need to turn RIGHT. La Verne Wine shop will be on your right hand side.

You will follow this road over a bridge that crosses the rail way tracks. Shortly thereafter, you will pass a sign for Paul Rene on your right. Keep following the road over the bridge that crosses the Breede River.

Immediately upon exiting the bridge, you will come to a fork in the road. The left fork goes to McGregor and the right fork to Agterkliphoogte/Le Chassieur.

You need to take the RIGHT fork.

Once on this road, you simply need to follow it to the very end! You will travel about 30km to get to our farm of which roughly 20km is tar and 10km is dirt.

Upon accessing the tar road, you will pass Sumsare Cellars on your right. Shortly thereafter, you will also pass Wandsbeck Cellars, also on your right.

Please continue to stay on this road and do not turn off anywhere!

You will then pass Sewenfontein farm on your left, followed by Wilhelm Buchels, school, also on your left. You will then cross a cattle grid and follow the road through a dip where you will see our neighbours solar panels on your right.

As you come up through the dip (please take things slow and carefully on this section on the road, it is a bit of a blind corner and sometimes cars coming in the opposite direction can be driving to the centre of the road), you will soon come across a farm on your left called Vergenoeg.

Please continue past Vergenoeg (please drive slowly on this section of the road – our neighbour often has baby ostriches in cages along this section and with the dryness, the cars do kick up a lot of dust which they don't enjoy! The workers children do also like to sit on the side of the road and wave at the cars as they pass!), and follow the road up and over the hill.

As you come to the top of the hill, you will find Good Hope Farm nestled at the base of the Riviersonderend Mountains.

Please continue to the bottom of the road. There is a security gate.

The code to enter is 1212#. And the code to exit is 9453#.

Please follow the road up to the main house to check in!
